CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entries must conform to the rules of the Exhibition.

- 1. The Exhibition is open to any photographer residing in the U.K. and C.I.
- 2. Copyright of the image and any components used must belong to the author.
- 3. The Guernsey Salon has the right to use any image entered for publicity purposes including use on a CD and our website.
- 4. Where manipulation or adjustment has been applied, this must have been carried out by the entrant.
- 5. All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and appropriate fee.
- 6. All submitted CDs / DVDs will be destroyed at the end of the exhibition.
- 7. Entries must not have been accepted into any previous Guernsey Salon Exhibition or be very similar to a previous accepted image in any class.
- 8. Mono definition: White and any shades of a single colour. If any other colour, no matter how small, is included it is then deemed to be a colour image and will be discarded and omitted from selection.
- 9. An individual image may only be entered into one class of the exhibition and must not be very similar to an entry in another class.
- 10. An image may be removed from the Exhibition if in the reasonable opinion of the Guernsey Salon committee the image does not conform to the entry conditions or is deemed unsuitable for public exhibition.
- 11. Each Author may submit up to a maximum of four entries per class.
- 12. Where an entry is received without payment it will not be judged,
- 13. The Guernsey Salon has only one selector (judge) so marks are not given to each image. The selector ranks the images e.g. 'In', 'Maybe' and 'Out'. If there are too many 'In' then a second or third ranking is carried out until the appropriate number of acceptances are achieved.
- 14. The submission of an entry signifies acceptance of these rules and conditions

ENTRY FEES & SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A maximum of four images may be entered into each class; the entry fee is £5.00 per class. Please make cheques payable to *Guernsey Salon of Photography*.

Any errors may result in your entry being omitted.

All images will be judged/projected in landscape format up to 1600 pixels wide x 1200 pixels high including any borders and must be submitted no larger than this format. Free space around the image must be filled with black. Entries must be in sRGB colour space and must be saved as JPEG files. (not .tiff)

To submit your entries, you must follow these guides.

On your CD create a new folder for each of the classes you wish to enter.

The folder should be named with the class entered & your name & any photographic honours.

Entries for each section must be placed within the appropriate folder.

Images must be named with image number and image title corresponding to the entry form.

A space must be left between the number and title, upper and lower characters may be used.
